Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) is a method of authentication in which a user is granted access to UDPaaS only after successfully entering verification code.

How to login with Multi-Factor Authentication:

- 1. Login to VHA Grants using your email and password.
- 2. An Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) page will be displayed. Below is a sample:

Checking this box will let you log in UDPaaS without asking for Multi-Factor Authentication code for 30 days. If the box is unchecked, you will be asked for Multi-Factor Authentication code the next time you login.
- 6. Click Submit.
